Alfred W. Harris founded present-day Virginia State University (VSU) in 1882. It was then known as Virginia Normal and College Institute and represented the nation's first fully state-assisted college or university for blacks. Today, only about one-third of VSU's operating budget comes from state funding.

A comprehensive university, VSU is one of two land-grant institutions in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Our mission is to promote and sustain academic programs that integrate instruction, research, and extension/public service in a design most responsive to the needs and endeavors of individuals within our scope of influence.

The University educates over 4,600 students who are majoring in one of 34 undergraduate programs leading to a bachelor's degree and 18 graduate level, master's and doctoral programs.

Ultimately, the University is dedicated to the promotion of knowledgeable, perceptive, and humane citizens – secure in their self-awareness, equipped for personal fulfillment, sensitive to the needs and aspirations of others, and committed to assuming productive roles in an ever-changing global society.

Through community involvement, a challenging academic program, diverse student organizations and exciting extracurricular activities, Virginia State University is Virginia's Opportunity University.

THE IDEAL VSU EMPLOYEE



Dr. Linda Person



The Ideal Team Player, written by leadership development guru Patrick Lencioni, is a book that details how to recognize and cultivate three essential virtues of an employee. Hungry, humble and smart, respectively, refers to an employee's self-motivation and diligence; willingness to think of themselves less, and interpersonal appropriateness and awareness. There are more than 800 outstanding and diverse Virginia State University employees; all of them exhibit at least one virtue, while dozens embody all three. Of those who also make financial investments in the University, many were identified. For this edition of the annual report, we highlight Dr. Linda Person, chair of the Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance department (HPERD).

Dr. Linda Person, '75 is a 27-year campus veteran—working as a professor, women's tennis coach and, for the past six years, department chair. In the spirit of embodying hungry, humble and smart, Dr. Person shared her greatest success as a VSU employee, her philosophy on building relationships and her thoughts on empowering her subordinates and students to lead:

Greatest successes as chair, professor and tennis coach at VSU:

As chair, I am very excited about the opportunity to bring about an awareness of the new trends in health, physical education and sport management fields. Over the past five years, the department has grown with more students and new career interests. It is hoped (in the development process) that we will have a new major in Sport Management and a major in Public Health. My coaching career at VSU has been my greatest achievement during my 33 years as a coach. My 2008 tennis team made history and won the first tennis championship for VSU. Teams under my leadership won eight divisional championships and appeared in four finals in the CIAA championships. I was named "CIAA Coach of the Year" seven times.

Her philosophy on building relationships and working with others across campus:

I recall the old saying, "treat others as you want to be treated." As a child, I was taught to be kind to people and understand that all people desire to be loved, wanted and needed, but I rarely smiled. When I became a college student, my roommate smiled all the time. I observed her natural ability to attract people, coax smiles and spur communication from strangers. I began to smile too, and it made a difference in how people received me. This behavior has been a part of my daily work habits throughout my entire professional career. Smiles break down barriers and opens doors for kindness and trustworthiness. It is a great way to begin building on relationships and new friendships.

Her thoughts on elevating/empowering subordinates and students to lead:

You get so much more out of employees when they are happy, and enjoy working and spending time with one another. Also, they want to feel that they are contributing to the common good and growth of the program; one way to do this is to involve them in the development process. Also, it is important to recognize each and every individual regardless of their level of responsibility because people need to feel valued. Lastly, everyone has a special strength, but it is up to the leader to get to know each person and discern their strengths. I try to delegate responsibility according to the strength of that person and the task to accomplish, and I believe that this will build extrinsic motivation and encourage above average performance (and higher) in all individuals. This road has not been easy for me and I certainly have learned from my mistakes. I continue to embrace the learning process as it is a constant process.

POINTS OF PRIDE



GRANTS/RESEARCH

- The University received an additional \$1.76 million from the Wallace Foundation to continue the transformative work on the national based University Principal Preparation Initiative.

- Virginia State University joins a program under Verizon Innovative Learning, the education initiative of the Verizon Foundation, to offer minority males from middle schools in Petersburg, Hopewell and Dinwiddie summer intensive courses in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM).

NOTEWORTHY

- The University received its fourth consecutive Tree Campus USA Award. VSU was recognized by the Arbor Day Foundation for its commitment to campus forestry management and environmental stewardship.
- Trojans Wynton Smith and Giovaunni Gee-Miles won first place at the Emerging Researchers National Conference in Washington, D.C.
- The Council on International Educational Exchange (CIEE) in partnership with the Penn Center for Minority Serving Institutions (CMSI) has awarded two VSU students a Global Fellows scholarship to fund their participation in a four-week credit-bearing education abroad program in Europe during summer 2018. Myia Jones, a junior business marketing major from Chesapeake, Virginia, will study at the CIEE Global Institute in Berlin, Germany. Ke-ana Williams, a junior mass communications major from Alexandria, Virginia, will study at the CIEE Global Institute in London, England.

The scholarship provides an opportunity for student leaders to gain global perspectives through cultural immersion experiences. Upon completion of their program abroad, the students will be expected to serve as study abroad ambassadors on campus and help facilitate workshops/sessions where they will share their study abroad experience with their peers.

- The National Association for Communication Excellence in Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Life and Human Sciences (ACE) awarded the VSU Extension Marketing & Communications Department four awards for their work last year (2017).

The department received a gold award in the Print Ad Category for an unprecedented ad that represented both Virginia Tech and VSU in Virginia Agriculture Magazine. In the Info Technology/Technology Education Category, the department received a silver award for a WebEx photography presentation it created and delivered at last year's virtual Virginia Cooperative Extension Winter Conference. A silver award was also received in the Diversity/Publications for Diverse Audiences Category for the 2017 Spring/Summer issue of Connection Magazine. Additionally, another silver award was received in the Diversity/Electronic Media and Audio for Targeted Audiences Category for the 2017 Small Farmer of the Year video.

- Keyashia Willis, a junior biology major was elected to serve on the Board of Directors of the National Collegiate Honors Council (NCHC) for 2018. NCHC is the largest membership organization supporting honors education in the United States. Keyashia is the first student from VSU to be elected to the NCHC Board of Directors.
- Emmy award-winning director and producer Jesse Vaughan, who serves as the creative director of Advance Creative Service Group at VSU, was inducted into the Virginia Communications Hall of Fame.

ATHLETICS

- The Men's Indoor Track and Field were crowned Co-CIAA Champions.
- Head Men's Basketball Coach Lonnie Blow, Jr. was the 2018 Central Intercollegiate Athletics Association Coach of the Year.
- The men's basketball team made an appearance in the 2018 NCAA DII Men's Basketball Atlantic Region Tournament. The Trojans also hosted the Atlantic Regional tournament for the first time in school history due to the Trojans securing the No. 1 ranking in the Atlantic Region.
- The women's tennis team (11-4, 8-3 CIAA, 6-0 North) claimed the CIAA Northern Division title for the regular season.

VERIZON INNOVATIVE LEARNING PROGRAM AT VSU



Thanks to a \$300,000 grant from the Verizon Foundation, Virginia State University hosted an education initiative this summer that offered intensive STEM courses to minority males from middle schools in Petersburg, Hopewell, Dinwiddie and surrounding areas. Launched in 2015, the Verizon Innovative Learning program works with Historically Black Colleges and Universities and Hispanic Serving Institutions to prepare minority male students in middle school for the STEM careers of the future. The program provides free technology, free access and innovative curricula to these under-resourced students who may be impacted by the digital divide.

Students participating in the program are invited to university and college campuses for summer courses that provide entrepreneurship training, hands-on learning experiences in next-gen technologies like robotics, augmented reality, and 3D printing, and access to college-aged mentors. Following the summer courses, students are invited back to the universities for monthly STEM education courses and mentoring. More than 1,400 students have participated in the Verizon Innovative Learning program to date. Results from the 2016-2017 school year show that 91 percent of student participants demonstrated an increased ability in science and 90 percent had an increased ability in math.

VSU served 70 students, and joined 24 HBCUs and HSIs nationwide for this initiative. The University also won the social media contest for two of the three weeks of the program-- winners were selected based on volume and quality of post, as well as authenticity in the depiction of programming.

"Virginia State University was built on a rich tradition of service and the ideals of passion and perseverance to make a difference," said President Makola M. Abdullah, Ph.D. "We thank Verizon for establishing this Verizon Innovative Learning program which addresses the shortage of minority males in the STEM fields. Together, we will have the power to change the lives of countless individuals who will be successful in making a difference in not only their lives but also in our communities."

Three Virginia State University graduates served as instructors for the program. The lead mentor and logistics coordinator graduated from the Professional Education program in May 2018.

Some time later, Peggy Davis, the director of athletics started the Athletic Club and asked for 1,000 people to step up and give \$1,000, so I did. When I look back over the years, the reason for me doing what I do is to help the students of VSU to have a better opportunity than I had. If people don't make the sacrifice to provide funds for scholarships, then how would students such as my daughter have an opportunity to receive a scholarship? For me, it is all about helping students get the education they need, and if I have to make a sacrifice then that is what I am going to do."

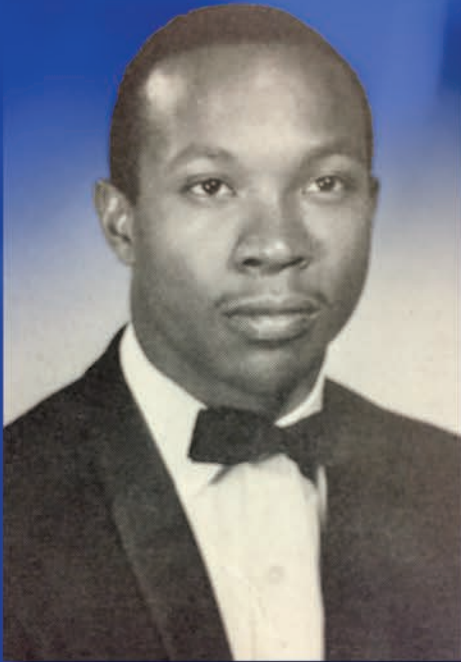

THE VASSAR W. HURT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



1st Lt. Vassar W. Hurt III, '68, a Health and Physical Education major and ROTC cadet, was commissioned in July of the same year. Shortly after graduation, Hurt was deployed to serve in Vietnam and later killed in action in 1970. Hurt was inducted into the Virginia State University ROTC Hall of Fame in 1997. His friends and fellow alumni are committed to keeping his memory alive by helping ROTC students each year through the Vassar W. Hurt Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Established in 1990, the scholarship awards full in-state tuition to a VSU ROTC sophomore, junior or senior. To date, the fund has awarded approximately \$82,945 in scholarships to 47 cadets.

A DONOR BILL OF RIGHTS



PHILANTHROPY is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the not-for-profit organizations and causes they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have these rights:

I.

To be informed of the organization's mission, of the way the organization intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.

II.

To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgement in its stewardship responsibilities.

III.

To have access to the organization's most recent financial statements.

IV.

To be assured their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.

V.

To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.

VI.

To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.

VII.

To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations of interest to the donor will be professional in nature.

VIII.

To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the organization or hired solicitors.

IX.

To have the opportunity for their names to be deleted from mailing lists that an organization may intend to share.

X.

To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
