Fire and Life Safety

- Generator load tests Completed 1/5/24
- Functional smoke detectors Ongoing
- Inspections on the life safety systems Completed 12/31/23
- Broken pull stations in the stairwells Ongoing*
- Broken fire doors and fire door hardware Temporary fix 1/10/24; Permanent doors ordered
- Sprinkler inspection Completed 12/15/23
- Extreme fire lane parking Completed 12/15/23





Small fire occured in washer/dryer unit in Williams Hall. There was smoke damage throughout building, and students were relocated to Comfort Inn.

ServePro LLC was contracted to mediate clean-up. They sanitized and deodorized the entire structure which took approximately 2 weeks.

New smoke detectors were installed. Building placed under fire watch and cleared for re-ocupation on 1/24/24.



Students moved back into residence hall 1/26/24. New fire alarm system has been ordered and will be installed in late February/March.
