

PRAXIS II Assessment Data

The PRAXIS II Content Knowledge tests measure whether prospective teachers have the standards-relevant knowledge, skills, and abilities believed necessary for competent professional practice. These assessments measure your general and subject-specific teaching skills and knowledge. They feature selected-response and constructed response items. The Praxis® tests are administered through an international network of test centers, which includes Prometric® test centers and Strategic Testing Networks (STNs) located in colleges and universities. All tests are delivered by computer, except for Braille Proficiency (0633), and are offered throughout the year.

The teacher candidates who participated in clinical practice during the 2022-2023 academic year passed their PRAXIS II assessment at an overall average of 86%. This is strong evidence that our program completers have a strong understanding of the content they will be teaching
