Applications

Submitting an application does not ensure acceptance to the program.

If you are accepted into this program, you must agree to the following requirements:

Requirements

1. Agree to participate in tutoring, take and pass for the Teaching Reading exams.
2. Take and pass the Praxis II (Elementary only).
3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher throughout the Master's program.



4. Commit to working as an Instructional Aide (Elementary) or a paraprofessional (Special Education) in Petersburg or Prince George public schools for the duration of the program, and as a licensed teacher 3 years post-completion.
5. Sign the Statement of Agreement by Teacher Apprentices to meet all requirements within a year of acceptance.
