Evaluation Criteria for VSU-EDAP Program

1. Current Enrollment Status at University (0-10 points)

Currently Enrolled Students:

- Progress in Program (5 points): candidate's academic progress based on transcripts and feedback from professors.
- Grades (5 points): GPA and overall performance in current courses.

Starting Fall 2024 Students:

- Acceptance Status (5 points): Confirmation of the candidate's acceptance into the graduate program.
- Preparedness (5 points): candidate's readiness for graduate studies based on their application materials and personal statement.

2. Academic Performance (0-20 points)

- o For currently enrolled students, r current GPA and performance in relevant coursework.
- o For new students, previous academic performance, including GPA and relevance of past coursework to the intended graduate program.

3. **Previous Educational Background** (0-15 points)

- o Quality and relevance of previous degrees.
- o GPA and academic achievements from previous education.

4. **Professional Performance and Potential** (0-20 points)

- Work performance (10 points): Based on job performance reviews, achievements, and contributions to their department.
- o Leadership potential (5 points): potential for leadership roles within the university.
- Contributions to department/university (5 points): Significant contributions made to department or the university.

5. Alignment with University Goals (0-15 points)

- Degree alignment (10 points): How well the candidate's degree aligns with the university's strategic goals and mission.
- Enhancement potential (5 points): The potential for the candidate's degree to enhance their contributions to the university.

6. **Personal Statement** (0-10 points)

- Clarity of career goals (4 points): clarity and feasibility of the candidate's career goals.
- o Motivation (4 points): candidate's motivation for pursuing the degree.
- o Impact on personal and professional growth (2 points): how the degree will benefit the candidate's personal and professional development.

7. Letters of Recommendation (0-5 points)

- Strength (3 points): strength and detail of the recommendations.
- Relevance (2 points): How well the recommendations endorse the candidate's abilities and potential.

8. University Involvement and Contributions (0-5 points)

- o Involvement in university activities, committees, or projects.
- Contributions to enhancing the university community through service, initiatives, or leadership roles.
