Virginia State University Parade Guidelines

The Virginia State University Homecoming Committee reserves the right to disqualify any unit considered inappropriate or unsafe for the parade.

- All floats must be inspected before the parade.
- <u>High school bands that stop and perform routines along the parade route will be eliminated from future participation!</u>
- There is a limit of one unit per organization. (1 unit =10 Motorcycles, 5 Cars)
- All parade units are to keep moving. No unit is to stop and perform a routine
- All participants 15 years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult.
- All vehicles entered by non-campus organizations must be decorated and identified with the company or organization name legibly written or printed.
- All towed floats must have safety hinges on the hitch.
- Throwing candy or other objects from vehicles or floats is prohibited.
- It is mandatory that fire-resistant materials be used to decorate floats and vehicles
- Drivers participating in the parade will not smoke, drink, or eat.
- Each unit must maintain a distance of one car length between units.
- No person will be allowed to ride on the hood or trunk of cars.
- No loud music is to be played in vehicles during the parade.
- Any late arrival **WILL NOT** participate in this year's parade
